The Houston Visiting Christian Science Nurse Service sponsored a presentation on October 22 at Seventh Church on "Life and Estate Planning Documents." This very informative talk was given by local Christian Scientist and attorney Michael S. Holmes.

Mike discussed the importance of documents that individuals can prepare should they become unable to make financial decisions, health care decisions, and other kinds of decisions for themselves. These documents include durable power of attorney (DPA), medical power of attorney (MPOA), directive to physicians, Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) authorization, Do Not Resuscitate (DNR) instructions, and the appointment of a guardian. Prayerful attention to these documents can help individuals decide how to best meet their own needs and the needs of their families.

Mike explained situations Christian Scientists may face when family members resist Christian Science treatment for their loved one. He emphasized the benefits of preparing documents in advance of a challenging situation. Also, he shared information on key estate planning documents, such as wills and trusts, and defined some of the legal terms found in these documents. At the conclusion of his talk, Mike shared information on helpful resources.

HVCSNS is extremely grateful to Mike for generously providing this interesting and valuable information to our Christian Science community. We appreciate, too, that he graciously agreed to make his PowerPoint slides available.
